To ensure a safe, fair, and competitive event, all riders, crew members, and spectators must comply with the following rules and regulations.

1. Race Format

- The event will follow a **2-Moto Format**.
- Overall finishing positions will be determined by combined moto scores.
- In the event of a tie, second moto finishing position will determine the overall winner.
- Race officials reserve the right to combine, split, or modify classes based on rider turnout.

2. Scoring & Transponders

- All riders are required to use the event-issued transponder scoring system.
- Riders are responsible for ensuring their transponder is properly mounted and functioning.
- Riders may be charged for lost or damaged transponders.
- Official results will be determined by transponder scoring and race officials.

3. Safety Equipment

The following equipment is required at all times while riding:

- DOT or Snell approved helmet
- Motocross boots
- Long pants
- Long sleeve jersey or riding shirt
- Eye protection (goggles or approved eyewear)

Failure to wear required safety equipment may result in disqualification.

6. Rider Conduct

- Riders must conduct themselves in a safe and sportsmanlike manner.
- Reckless riding may result in penalties or disqualification.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct toward officials, staff, riders, or spectators will not be tolerated.
- Race officials have final authority on all rulings and disputes.

7. Pit Area Rules

- No reckless riding in the pit area.
- Riders under 18 must have a parent or legal guardian present.
- Pit vehicles must be operated safely at all times.
- Riders are responsible for the actions of their crew members and guests.

8. Liability

Participation in motocross racing is inherently dangerous. All riders and spectators assume all risks associated with participation and attendance. The Jackson County Fair Board, event staff, sponsors, and property owners shall not be held liable for injuries, damages, or losses.

9. Rule Interpretation

Race officials reserve the right to interpret, modify, or enforce rules as necessary to ensure a safe and fair event. All official decisions are final.
